REQUESTED ACTION


Authorize the Office of Professional Licensure and Certification (OPLC) to **retroactively** renew its membership with the Association of State and Provincial Psychology Boards (ASPPB), Tyrone, GA, vendor code 204399, in the amount of \$2,750.00 for the period January 1, 2026, to December 31, 2026, effective upon Governor and Council approval. 100% Agency Income.

EXPLANATION

The Association of State and Provincial Psychology Boards (ASPPB) is the membership organization composed of state psychology regulatory authorities that are responsible for licensure of psychologists throughout the United States and Canada. RSA 329-D: 1. Through its membership, ASPPB provides the New Hampshire Board of Psychology with use of the Coordinated Licensure Information System for the purpose of sharing information regarding psychologists' licensure and enforcement activities concerning psychology licensure laws. ASPPB also coordinates submission of Compact application requirements for the purpose of removing barriers to interstate practice. This request is retroactive as the agency received the invoice and required information after membership renewal.

6. *Are training or educational/research materials included in the membership? If so, is the cost included? Explain in detail:* **Yes. Board Member Training, Legislative research, and education, as well as advocacy are part of the services provided with ASPPB membership.**
