REQUESTED ACTION

Pursuant to RSA 14:30-a, VI, authorize the Department of Administrative Services, to accept and expend federal funds from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) State Fiscal Recovery Funds (SFRF) in the amount of \$340,275 for deferred maintenance related to building security improvements and repairs in Londergan Hall, effective upon Fiscal Committee and Governor and Executive Council approval through December 31, 2026. This is an allowable use of ARPA SFRF funds under Section 602(c)(1)(C) for provision of government services to the extent of reduction in revenue. **100% Federal Funds.**

EXPLANATION

The requested funds will be used for building security improvements, additional repair work that was discovered during the renovation project, and office space fit-up for the Department of Labor (a tenant of Londergan Hall).

Funds will be allocated as follows:

Class 048 – Contract Repairs, Bldg. Grounds – for contractual costs of building security improvements and repairs in Londergan Hall.

These funds are from repurposed ARPA SFRF, previously allocated to other projects.

In the event that Federal Funds become no longer available, General Funds will not be requested to support this project.
