REQUESTED ACTION

Authorize the Department of Military Affairs and Veterans Services to exercise a contract renewal option with Securitas Security Services, USA, Inc. (VC#175981), Manchester, New Hampshire, for armed security services at Pease Air National Guard Base in Newington, New Hampshire by increasing the price limitation by \$1,172,845.44 from \$2,260,740.88 to \$3,433,586.32 and extending the completion date from April 30, 2026, to April 30, 2027, effective for the period May 1, 2026, through April 30, 2027, upon Governor and Council approval. The original contract was approved by Governor and Council on April 10, 2024, item #38A, and amended on August 13, 2025, item #5A. **100% Federal Funds.**

Further, authorize a contingency in the amount of \$23,456.91 for unanticipated expenses bringing the contract total to \$3,457,043.23 effective for the period May 1, 2026, through April 30, 2027, upon Governor and Council approval. **100% Federal Funds.**

Funds are available in the following account for Fiscal Year 2026, with the authority to adjust encumbrances between fiscal years within the price limitation through the Budget Office, if needed and justified.

EXPLANATION

Securitas and the assigned security team at Pease Air National Guard Base have done an exceptional job during this initial contract term. The company keeps the New Hampshire Air National Guard informed of any and all concerns and activities across the entire installation. They provide activity logs for any concerns or issues that were found during patrols, and the team also provides weekly performance reports to leadership. Securitas management has also been extremely cooperative and helpful since day one in supporting the mission.

Air National Guard regulations and procedures, as promulgated by the National Guard Bureau; require that selected types of National Guard facilities be provided with security guard protection. These facilities include

those that are potential terrorist targets and those which are used to store high cost or large amounts of Federal equipment. The Pease Air National Guard Facility easily meets the Federal criteria for such protection as Pease is home of the 157th Air Refueling Wing that houses the KC-46 Pegasus aircraft. The Pease Air National Guard Base includes 220 acres, 147 facilities, roads, ramps, taxiways, and utility systems and runs "24/7" operations.

This contract also includes a contingency line for the purpose of the Department of Military Affairs and Veterans Services to request additional security over and above the regular manning outlined within the Scope of Services. There are situations where additional security guards are needed to cover certain events such as pre and post mobilization events, pre and post deployment ceremonies, special events, statewide pandemic drills, drill weekend traffic control and State Active-Duty Missions.

Funds to support this service are provided by the Federal Government and are administered under an existing Federal-State Agreement. Under the Agreement, the State of New Hampshire - Department of Military Affairs and Veterans Services provides these services and the Federal Government reimburses the State for the costs related to the services at the rate of 100%. In the event that Federal Funds are not available for this contract, General Funds will not be used.

This contract has been approved for form, substance, and execution by the New Hampshire Department of Justice.

Amendment #2

This Amendment to the Security Services – Pease Air National Guard Base contract is by and between the State of New Hampshire, Department of Military Affairs and Veterans Services (“State” or “Department”) and Securitas Security Services, USA, Inc. (“Contractor”).

WHEREAS, pursuant to an agreement (the “Contract”) approved by the Governor and Executive Council on April 10, 2024 (Item #38A), the Contractor agreed to perform certain services based upon the terms and conditions specified in the Contract and in consideration of certain sums specified; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Form P-37, version 02/23/2023, General Provisions, Paragraph 18, the Contract may be amended upon written agreement of the parties and approval from the Governor and Executive Council; and

WHEREAS, the parties agree to extend the term of the agreement, increase the price limitation, or modify the scope of services to support continued delivery of these services; and

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the mutual covenants and conditions contained in the Contract and set forth herein, the parties hereto agree to amend as follows:

1. Modify Form P-37 General Provisions, Block 1.7, Completion Date, to read:
 - a. 4/30/2027
2. Modify Form P-37, General Provisions, Block 1.8, Price Limitation, ADD not to exceed amount of \$1,196,302.35 for contract year May 1, 2026, to April 30, 2027, to read:
 - a. Not To Exceed \$3,457,043.23
3. Modify Exhibit B, Scope of Services by removing and replacing it in its entirety with the amended Exhibit B, Scope of Services attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein.
4. Modify Exhibit C, Contract Price by removing and replacing it in its entirety with the amended Exhibit C, Contract Price attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein.

All terms and conditions of the contract not modified by this Amendment #2 remain in full force and effect. This Amendment shall be effective May 1, 2026, or upon the date of Governor and Executive Council approval, whichever is later.



SUBJECT: Security Services – Pease Air National Guard Base

The contract price and financial arrangements for the services provided under this agreement shall be as follows:

1. The total contract amount for the period of May 1, 2026, through April 30, 2027, shall not exceed \$1,196,302.35 without amendment and approval of the Governor and Executive Council.
2. The contract amount for security services for the contract period, May 1, 2026, or upon Governor and Executive Council approval (whichever is later) through April 30, 2027, to include the contractor-provided supplies, equipment, property, insurance, and other ancillary costs as specified in EXHIBIT B (Scope of Services) of this agreement shall be \$1,172,845.44.
 - a. Monthly payments shall be paid by the State of New Hampshire to the Contractor for the period May 1, 2026, to April 30, 2027, in twelve (12) equal monthly payments of \$97,737.12.
3. The cost of the contingency line shall not exceed \$23,456.91. These additional security services will be requested by the Department in accordance with Section 22 of the Exhibit B, Scope of Services herein. If provided by the Contractor, these charges shall be invoiced separately.
4. The payments under this portion of the agreement shall be made to the Contractor at the end of each specified month of service during the term of the agreement and within 30 days after the receipt of a proper invoice by the Contractor.




