**REQUESTED ACTION**

Approve Beth Baldwin Trust's request to perform the following work on Wentworth Lake in Wolfeboro pursuant to NH Department of Environmental Services (NHDES) Wetlands Bureau permit #2025-03135, and in accordance with RSA 482-A:3. No comments were submitted by the Wolfeboro Conservation Commission regarding the project as proposed.

Retain the installation of 326 linear feet of coir logs placed along the bank along approximately 1,040 linear feet of frontage on Wentworth Lake in Wolfeboro.

NHDES imposed the following conditions as part of this approval:

1. In accordance with Env-Wt 307.16, all work shall be done in accordance with plans dated November 13, 2025 by Beth Baldwin, as received by the NH Department of Environmental Services (NHDES) on February 26, 2026.
2. In accordance with Env-Wt 514.05(b), bank restoration shall be maintained and monitored in a manner that will create a healthy riparian or lacustrine shoreline system.
3. All development activities associated with any project shall be maintained in compliance with applicable requirements of RSA 483-B and Env-Wq 1400 during and after construction as required pursuant to RSA 483-B:3.
4. Pursuant to RSA 483-B:9, V(a)(2)(D), (v), this permit does not authorize the removal of trees or saplings within the waterfront buffer that would result in a tree and sapling point score below the minimum required per RSA 483-B:9, V(a)(2)(D), (iv).
5. Maintenance of this bank stabilization project shall adhere to the conditions and recommendations received from the Ecological Review Section in order to avoid and minimize project-related impacts to sensitive species identified by the DataCheck (DCT25-3300) per Env-Wt 311.01(b).

**EXPLANATION**

NHDES approved this project on March 15, 2026. NHDES supported its decision with the following findings:

1. This is a major impact project per Administrative Rule Env-Wt 514.07(c), bank stabilization exceeding 200 linear feet.
2. The NHDES finds that because the project is not of significant public interest as the project results in minor improvements of the shoreline and will not significantly impair the resources of Lake Wentworth, a public hearing under RSA 482-A:8 is not required.



3. No concerns were received from abutters nor the local Conservation Commission related to the project.
4. Per Rule Env-Wt 311.01(b), the applicant coordinated with the Ecological Review Section to determine how to avoid and minimize project-related impacts on rare or protected animal species and habitat, and on protected plants or exemplary natural communities.
5. The NHDES finds that the project as proposed and conditioned meets the requirements of RSA 482-A and the Wetlands Program Code of Administrative Rules Chapters Env-Wt 100 - 900. No waivers of RSA 482-A or the Wetlands Program Code of Administrative Rules Chapters Env-Wt 100 - 900 were requested or approved under this permit action.

NHDES Wetlands Bureau permit #2025-03135 application documents are enclosed for review by the Governor and the Executive Council in consideration of this request and in accordance with RSA 482-A:3, II(a), as it is a major project located in New Hampshire public waters.

Provide a description of the project and the purpose of the project, the need for the proposed impacts to jurisdictional areas, an outline of the scope of work to be performed, and whether impacts are temporary or permanent.

During the 2023 draw down of Lake Wentworth, in consultation with the Wentworth Watershed Association and environmental consultant Matt Lundsted, who was referred by the WWA, we did a project placing cow logs under the eroded bank. The logs were placed by hand, and native plants were planted to encourage integrating the logs and the shore. In the fall, we placed organic material - leaves + pine needles - behind the logs to fill in any gaps. As a result the plants are thriving and vegetation from the shore has taken root in the logs. Due to this success, we put more down and they are keeping the bank from further erosion. Visually the cow logs have weathered and look completely natural as they do the job. We didn't think we needed a permit, because the work was done by hand during the drawdown with entirely organic materials. No trees were removed, instead we planted woody debris to enhance wildlife. The impacts are semi-permanent - they will stay there, but over time their form will change as they become one with the bank.
