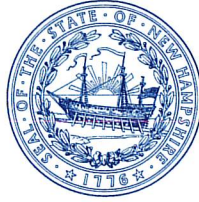

**REQUESTED ACTION**

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to appoint Jennifer L. DiGeorge to Position #9U751 (Appropriation #02-20-20-200510-23090000-014-500134), as a Criminal Justice Investigator at a salary level of \$87,780 (LG BB, Step 6), effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval, or June 17, 2026, whichever is later, for a term ending July 1, 2028. 100% General Funds.

**EXPLANATION**

Ms. DiGeorge, an Auburn resident, earned an Associate of Science in Criminal Justice from New Hampshire Technical Institute (with high honors) in 2013, and a Bachelor of Science in Legal Studies (with honors) in 2016. She began working in law enforcement as a Telecommunications Specialist at the Department of Safety from 2013 to 2016. While serving as a Deputy Sheriff at the Merrimack County Sheriff's Office from 2017 to 2022, she was certified as a SPOTS operator, Bicycle Patrol Officer, and R.A.D. (rape aggression defense) Instructor. She served as a Police Officer with the Pelham Police Department from 2022 to 2024. In addition, Ms. DiGeorge has contributed to her community by actively participating in National Night Out, Storytime with a Sheriff, United Way Day of Caring, and Money Start programs. In 2024, she began working towards her Master of Science in Public Safety Administration at Southern New Hampshire University. Ms. DiGeorge joined the Department as a Criminal Justice Investigator in 2024 and was assigned to a temporary position in the Criminal Justice Bureau.
