**REQUESTED ACTION**

Authorize the Department of Environmental Services to amend a Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances Remediation (PFAS) grant (PO# 1096678) to Hanafin Farms Condominium Association, Londonderry, NH (VC# 474771-B001), by extending the completion date to December 31, 2027 from June 30, 2026, to finance the interconnection to a municipal public water supply, effective upon Governor and Council approval though December 31, 2027. The original grant was approved by Governor and Council on November 29, 2023, Item #78. This is a no cost time extension. 100% PFAS Response Funds.

**EXPLANATION**

We are requesting approval of this amendment to provide Hanafin Farms Condominium Association with additional time to complete their interconnection project. The project will address per- and poly-fluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) within the existing sole source of drinking water. The watermain that will serve Hanafin Farms Condominium Association has been partially installed as part of another ongoing project. The main does exist at the entrance to the community but water is not yet flowing through the pipe. Providing them with this time extension will allow them to complete the work within the Association and interconnect to the newly extended watermain when it is completed.

The PFAS Fund was created, as authorized by RSA 485-H, to provide low interest loans and grants to community public water systems; non-profit, non-transient, non-community public water systems; municipalities; and wastewater facilities to address exceedances of PFAS standards for costs incurred after September 30, 2019. Grant and loan applications are accepted year-round and reviewed for eligibility in the order in which the applications are received.

To date, \$356,264.02 of the original \$605,000 grant has been spent. This grant amendment has been approved by the Attorney General's Office as to form, substance and execution.

We respectfully request your approval of this item.

This Agreement (hereinafter called the Amendment) is by and between the State of New Hampshire, acting by and through its Department of Environmental Services (hereinafter referred to as the State) and Hanafin Farms Condominium Association acting by and through the Chair of the PFAS Remediation Water Project Committee, James Blanchette (hereinafter referred to as the Grantee).

WHEREAS, pursuant to an Agreement (hereinafter called the Agreement) approved by the Governor and Council on November 29, 2023, the Grantee agreed to perform certain services upon the terms and conditions specified in the Agreement and in consideration of payment by the State of certain sums as specified therein; and


WHEREAS, The Grantee and the State have agreed to amend the Agreement in certain respects;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, and the covenants and conditions contained in the Agreement and set forth herein, the parties hereto do hereby agree as follows:


1. Amendment and Modification of Agreement: The Agreement is hereby amended as follows:  
  
(A) The Completion Date as set forth in sub-paragraph 1.7 of the Agreement shall be changed from June 30, 2026, to December 31, 2027.
2. Effective Date of Amendment; This Amendment shall take effect upon the date of approval of this Amendment by the Governor and Executive Council of the State of New Hampshire.
3. Continuance of Agreement: Except as specifically amended and modified by the terms and conditions of this Amendment, the Agreement, and the obligations of the parties thereunder, shall remain in full force and effect in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth therein.

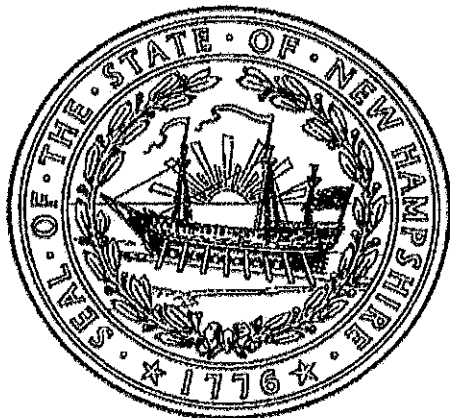
