REQUESTED ACTION

Authorize the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) to exercise a two-year extension option and amend the existing contract with ReVision Energy, Inc., (VC# 309329) South Portland, Maine for Electric Vehicle Charging Services at 33 Green Street in Concord by extending the contract completion date from June 30, 2026 to June 30, 2028, at no cost to the State, effective upon Governor and Executive Council Approval. The original contract was approved by Governor and Executive Council on March 24, 2021, item #104.

There is no cost to the State as the cost of the electric charging services are paid by end users through the established electric charging rate structure.

EXPLANATION

In accordance with RSA 21-I:12, II B, the Department of Administrative Services, Division of Plant and Property is responsible to "provide for the general maintenance of state-owned buildings and grounds, except as otherwise provided by law." The Division of Plant and Property maintains 95 state-owned facilities located throughout the state, including the parking facility at 33 Green Street in Concord where four electric vehicle charging stations are located. The proposed amendment would exercise the contract's two-year extension option, allowing ReVision Energy, Inc. to continue maintaining the charging stations and associated billing systems through June 30, 2028.

In April 2020, DAS partnered with the Department of Environmental Services and the NH Office of Strategic Initiatives to issue a Request for Proposals for Electrical Vehicle Charging. Five proposals were received. An evaluation team consisting of representatives from these state agencies, rated each proposal using criteria established and published in the RFP. The criteria were broken down into the following areas; project cost 55 points, company qualifications 15 points, proposed solution and customer cost 20 points and overall quality and responsiveness 10 points. Based on the evaluation criteria. Revision Energy, Inc., was the highest scoring vendor. A copy of the original contract and scoring documentation is attached.

Under the current contract Revision Energy owns the equipment and is responsible for full maintenance and operation of the charging stations, including all billing functions. ReVision provides monthly usage data to the State and reimburses the State for electricity consumed at the site. In addition,

the State receives a monthly premium calculated based on the average number of charging sessions per day, using a sliding-scale rate. At the current average of seven charging sessions per day, the premium rate is \$0.060 per kWh used. Annual premium payments to the State average approximately \$2,000.

The contract extension will allow the State to continue providing public EV charging services with no cost to the State and with continued monthly revenue from charging activity. Based on the foregoing, I am respectfully recommending approval of the contract extension amendment with Revision Energy, Inc.

**AMENDMENT 1 TO
THE CONTRACT BETWEEN REVISION ENERGY, INC.
AND
THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES**

This First Amendment (hereinafter referred to as the "Amendment") is by and between the State of New Hampshire, Department of Administrative Services (hereinafter referred to as the "State") and ReVision Energy, Inc., (hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor") (collectively, "the Parties") for Electric Vehicle Charging Services at 33 Green Street in Concord, NH.

WHEREAS, the current Contract, approved by the Governor and Executive Council on March 24, 2021 (Item # 104), provides for an initial term of approximately five and one half years (Exhibit B, Section 2).

WHEREAS, the Contract has a provision to extend the initial term of five and one half years for one term of two additional years subject to approval by NH Governor and Council.

WHEREAS the Parties desire to extend the Contract two additional years ending on June 30, 2028.

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties mutually agree to amend the Contract, as follows:

1. Delete in its entirety section 1.7 Completion Date and substitute therefore the following:

1.7 Completion Date June 30, 2028

2. Delete the Primary contact for the Contractor and the State in Exhibit B, Paragraph 28, Dispute Resolution Responsibility and Schedule Table, and substitute therefore the following:

Primary	Dan Clapp, Co-founder	Sarah Trask, State Contract Officer	10 Business Days
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3. Amend the Contractor and State Contact in Exhibit B, Paragraph 29.

Replace Barry Woods, Director of Electrical Vehicle Innovation with Dan Clapp, Co-Founder. Replace Michael Connor, Administrator with Sarah Trask, Deputy Director Division of Plant and Property.

4. Delete in its entirety Exhibit C, Paragraph 1, and substitute therefore the following:

The Contractor hereby agrees to provide "Electric Vehicle Charging Services" at **no cost** to the State for the period commencing on March 24, 2021 June 30, 2028 in return for the services described in Exhibit B.


5. Amend Exhibit C, Paragraph 5, to replace the contact in the current address listed with


