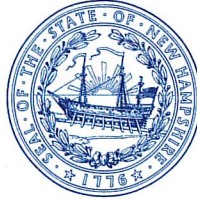

Your Excellency and Members of the Council:

**REQUESTED ACTION**

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to appoint Michael R. Imbrogno as an Attorney to Position #9U599 (Appropriation #02-20-20-200510-26200000-013-500132) at a salary level of \$87,000, effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval, or July 24, 2026, whichever is later. 100% General Funds.

**EXPLANATION**

Mr. Imbrogno, a Hooksett resident, earned his Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice, from Pennsylvania State University in 2017, with a minor in Political Science. In 2024, he earned his Juris Doctor from the University of New Hampshire Franklin Pierce School of Law. He began his legal career at the Concord City Prosecutor's Office as an Assistant City Prosecutor, where he handled violation and misdemeanor level offenses up to and including conducting bench trials, conducted probable cause hearings for felony level offenses, and appeared in court for arraignments, bail hearings, and motion hearings. Considering Mr. Imbrogno's experience, I am requesting that he be appointed as an Attorney with a salary of \$87,000. He will be assigned to the Civil Law Bureau's Elections Law Unit. His resume is attached.

RSA 21-M:3 and RSA 94:1-a(I)(c) provide that the designation of positions, salary levels, and salary increases for attorneys at the Department of Justice shall be determined by the Attorney General, subject to approval of the Governor and Council, within appropriations made to the Department of Justice.


