REQUESTED ACTION

Authorize the NH Department of Corrections (NHDOC) to accept and expend funds from the New Hampshire Department of Justice (NHDOJ), made available through a Victims of Crime Act sub grant, in the amount of \$55,317.53 for the provision of Victim Information and Notification Everyday (VINE®) system. Effective upon Governor and Council approval June 30, 2027. 100% Federal Transfer from other Agencies.

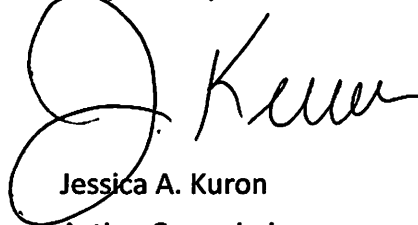
NH DOC requests authorization to accept and expend funds from the NHDOJ in the amount of \$55,317.53 for the provision of Victim Information and Notification Everyday (VINE®) services.

VINE® is a free notification system that provides updated custody information through automated notifications by telephone, e-mail, text message or text telephone devices (TTY) to victims of crime, survivors, the general public, law enforcement and public servants.

On June 3, 2026, the Governor and Council approved the NHDOC to renew the existing sole source contract with Appriss Insights LLC effective July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2029, item #37.

On June 17, 2026, the Governor and Council approved grant funding for NH Department of Corrections in the amount of \$151,967 with \$55,317.53 designated to direct VINE funding, item #153. The period for this funding is from July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027.
