REQUESTED ACTION

Authorize the Department of Safety, Division of State Police, to exercise the optional two-year extension provided under Contract DOS 2019-03 and enter into a **Sole Source** amendment with Computer Square, Inc. Technology Group, CSI (VC#312693-B001), Keasbey, NJ, for the State Police Computer Aided Dispatch and Records Management System, by increasing the price limitation by \$1,356,392.88 from \$6,526,179.00 to \$7,882,571.88 and by extending the completion date from August 31, 2026, to August 31, 2028, effective upon Governor and Council approval. The original contract was approved by Governor and Council on December 18, 2019, Item #153, and was most recently amended with Governor and Council approval on April 15, 2026, Item #84. 100% Transfer from Other Agency (original source: 100% Highway Funds).

Funds are available in Fiscal Year 2027 and are anticipated to be available in Fiscal Year 2028, upon the availability and continued appropriation of funds in the future operating budget, with the authority to adjust encumbrances between State Fiscal Years within the price limitation through the Budget Office, if needed and justified.

EXPLANATION

This request is **Sole Source** because the Department is increasing the price limitation by more than 10% of the original contract. Under MOP 150, amendments that increase the price limitation by more than 10% should be identified as sole source. The Department seeks to amend the existing contract with the contractor of record for the State Police Computer Aided Dispatch and Records Management System. The amendment adds a Major Incident Management Module (MIMS) and continues system maintenance within the existing CSI CAD/RMS platform. Because the module must integrate with the current CAD/RMS production environment, workflows, data model, status boards, notifications, audit controls, permissions, and NHSP-approved messaging channels, use of another vendor would require duplicative integration, additional testing and validation, parallel support, and increased operational risk.

The original contract was approved by Governor and Council on December 18, 2019, Item #153. The contract was subsequently amended with Governor and Council approval on October 13, 2021, Item #240; June 29, 2022, Item #171; December 20, 2023, Item #150; October 30, 2024, Item #110; December 17, 2025, Item #77; and April 15, 2026, Item #84.

The State Police CAD/RMS platform is a mission-critical public safety system used to support dispatch, records management, communications, command operations, field units, and partner agencies operating under NHSP authority. The system supports the intake, tracking, assignment, response, and documentation of public safety events. Continued support and maintenance are necessary to preserve operational continuity, system reliability, and secure access to dispatch and records information.

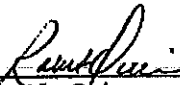
This amendment extends the contract completion date through August 31, 2028, and adds the Major Incident Management Module. The module will provide a dedicated incident workspace within the existing CAD/RMS system to support coordinated response during major incidents. Functionality includes incident alignment, shared status boards, role-based task assignments, checklists, escalation tracking, handoffs, operational period tracking, notification support, configuration tools for incident types and forms, workflow support, data retention, and training/documentation for dispatchers, command staff, administrators, and field users.

The Major Incident Management Module will improve the Department's ability to coordinate incident command, communications, dispatch operations, field response, and partner agency activity during large-scale or high-impact incidents. The module will also allow relevant CAD events and associated RMS records to be linked and maintained as a single source of truth, reducing manual coordination and improving situational awareness for command, communications, and field personnel.

Acceptance of the Major Incident Management Module will occur in accordance with the contract's acceptance and testing provisions, including model validation, user acceptance testing, and issuance of a Letter of System Acceptance before the module proceeds into ongoing support. Ongoing support will be provided under the existing agreement.

The original contract was competitively procured under RFP DOS 2019-03. CSI was selected through that procurement process and has implemented and maintained the State Police CAD/RMS environment. This amendment is not a new standalone procurement; it is an expansion and continuation of the existing production platform to support public safety operations and ensure continuity of the CAD/RMS system through August 31, 2028.

This Amendment (the 'Amendment') is entered into by and between the State of New Hampshire, acting through its Department of Safety, Division of State Police (the 'Department') and Computer Square, Inc., 330 Mac Lane, Keasbey, NJ 08832 ('Contractor'). The Department and Contractor are sometimes referred to herein singularly as a 'Party' and collectively as the 'Parties.'

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into that certain Agreement approved by Governor and Council, as a result of RFP DoS # 2019-03 on December 18, 2019, Item #153 and amended on October 13, 2021 (Item #5D), June 29, 2022 (Item #171), December 20, 2023 (Item #150), October 30, 2024 (Item #110), December 17, 2025 (Item #77), and April 15, 2026 (Item #84) (the 'Agreement') wherein Contractor agreed to provide, and the Department agreed to purchase, Computer-Aided Dispatch (CAD)/ Records Management System (RMS) system and related services in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth therein; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Paragraph 18 of the Agreement, the Parties wish to amend the Agreement as further specified herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration exchanged, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby conclusively acknowledged, the Parties hereby agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. Amend Section 1.7 of the State of New Hampshire P-37 General Provisions by amending the Completion Date to August 31, 2028.
2. Amend Section 1.8 of the State of New Hampshire P-37 General Provisions by increasing the Price Limitation by \$1,356,392.88 from \$6,526,179.00 to \$7,882,571.88.
3. Amend Exhibit A: Statement of Work

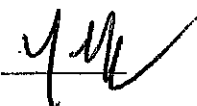
The Contractor shall develop and implement a Major Incident Module within the New Hampshire State Police (NHSP) CAD and RMS environment to provide coordinated response during major incidents. The module will deliver alignment, assignment, and visibility across command, dispatch, field units, and partner agencies operating under NHSP authority.

Scope of Services include:

- a) Incident alignment through Computer Square, Inc. Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) and Records Management System (RMS). The Contractor shall create a dedicated incident workspace with common objectives, operational periods, and shared status boards; ingest relevant CAD events and link associated RMS records to maintain a single source of truth.
- b) Assignment management: enable role-based tasking and unit assignments; support checklists, escalations, and handoffs; capture time stamps and outcomes; maintain a complete audit trail for all changes.

- c) Situational visibility: provide real-time dashboards for Command, Control, and Field Staff.
- d) Notifications and collaboration: integrate with existing NHSP CAD/RMS system to push updates to designated roles, including configurable alerting thresholds.
- e) Administration: provide configuration tools for incident types, forms, and workflows, and data retention.
- f) Training and Materials: Include user, supervisor, and administrator training materials and an operations guide as well as training coordination through the NHSP Justice Information Bureau.

Deliverables include:

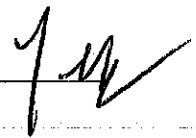
- 1) Functional and technical design documents covering any applicable data models, workflows, and interfaces.
- 2) Configured Major Incident Module in the NHSP production environment.
- 3) Validate integration with existing CAD and RMS services, identity and access management, and NHSP-approved messaging channels.
- 4) Test plan and test results demonstrating end-to-end operation, audit logging, and report generation.
- 5) Training and documentation for administrators, dispatch, command staff, and field users.

Acceptance of the Major Incident Module and its deliverables shall follow Exhibit A-3 (Acceptance and Testing Services), including Day-in-the-Life testing, audit logging validation, and issuance of a Letter of System Acceptance. Ongoing support shall be provided under Exhibit A-4 (Maintenance, Operations, and Support Services), including incident response Service Level Agreement (SLAs).
