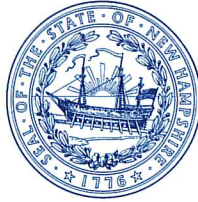

Your Excellency and Members of the Council:

REQUESTED ACTION

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to grant a salary increase to Andrew G. Macchione, as an Assistant Attorney General (Position #9U059, Appropriation #02-20-20-201010-33040000-013-500132), in the amount of \$4,560, from a salary level of \$100,440 to a salary level of \$105,000, effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval, or August 19, 2026, whichever is later. 100% Other Funds.

EXPLANATION

Mr. Macchione currently resides in Center Barnstead. He received his Bachelor of Science in Business Administration from Fitchburg State College in 1987, after completing his studies in 2.5 years. He earned his Juris Doctor in 1991 from the University of Virginia School of Law, where he was Development Editor of the *Virginia Environmental Law Journal*. From 1991 to 1996, he practiced corporate and bankruptcy law as an Associate with Martin, Lord & Osman in Plymouth, Laconia, and Lancaster. He developed and managed a bankruptcy and general practice at Hopkins Law Office in Plymouth from 1996 to 1997. Between 1998 and 2010, he was a solo practitioner in Plymouth focusing primarily on bankruptcy and contract law. Mr. Macchione has also worked in the private industry as Director of Operations at MOP Environmental Solutions (2010 to 2011), as New Hampshire Regulatory Affairs Manager at Tender Corporation (2011 to 2019), and as New Hampshire Operations Manager at Genfoot America, LLC (2019 to 2024). He has been active in his community as past Secretary of Trout Unlimited, Ammonoosuc Chapter, Board Member for the Bath Conservation Commission, and President of the Littleton Area Chamber of Commerce. Mr. Macchione joined the Department in 2024 and was assigned to the Debt Recovery Unit. His salary will increase by \$4,560 from \$100,440 to \$105,000. I plan to continue his current assignment.
