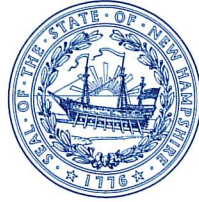

Your Excellency and Members of the Council:

REQUESTED ACTION

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to appoint Victoria Moore to Position #9U648 (Appropriation #02-20-20-200510-26100000-013-500132) as an Attorney, at a salary level of \$86,000, effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval, or September 4, 2026, whichever is later. 100% General Funds.

EXPLANATION

Ms. Moore, an Atkinson resident, graduated from the University of Texas at Arlington in 2020 with a Bachelor of Arts degree in History. She was a Moot Court TUMCA Regional Sweet 16 Finalist in 2019 and made the Dean's List all semesters. She earned her Juris Doctor from New England Law in Boston in 2023 where she made the Dean's List all semesters and was Executive Technical Editor of the *New England Law Review*. While in law school, she was a legal intern at LaMothe, McNiff, Relethford, LLC in Salem, Massachusetts, where she completed legal research in cases related to personal injury, criminal, and landlord tenant law. She drafted discovery questions, complaints, demand letters, and client letters. In 2022, she served as an intern for Justice Georges at the Massachusetts Supreme Judicial Court, where she reviewed appellate briefs, trial records, and petitions, and drafted recommendations for Supreme Judicial Court review. Later that year, she worked as a Housing Department Intern at Greater Boston Legal Services, where she interviewed clients, completed answer and discovery requests for Housing Court cases, and conducted legal research and analyzed case law related to Massachusetts Housing Court issues. She began her legal career as a Law Clerk at the New Hampshire Superior Court, where she reviewed various motions, completed legal research, analyzed case law, and drafted court orders for review by Superior Court judges. She also supervised interns and mentored other law clerks. Considering Ms. Moore's experience, I am requesting that she be appointed as an Attorney with a salary of \$86,000. She will be assigned to

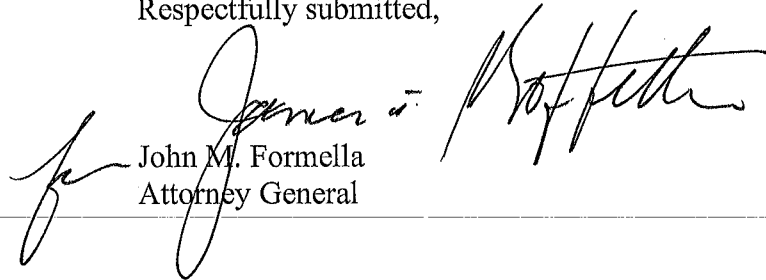
