Pursuant to RSA 21-I:54, I, authorize the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources (Department) to continue one full-time temporary 39-3090 RECR ATTNDNTS-3, Position #8T3131, SOC 39, Pay Band 3, effective upon Governor and Council approval for the period October 14, 2026, through June 30, 2027. **100% other funds**

**EXPLANATION**

This position is essential for the effective and efficient operations of Cannon Mountain and Franconia Notch State Park (Cannon/FNSP). The position supports various functions within Franconia Notch State Park, supporting retail as well as concession services to the thousands of visitors who frequent the state park year-round. Granting approval of this position extension will allow the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources to continue to provide the needed direct support to maintain visitor service, retail and concession operations at Cannon Mountain and Franconia Notch State Park. For this reason, we seek to continue employment of the position.

The Department is seeking extension of this position through the end of Fiscal Year 2027 with the intention of establishing it as a Full Time temporary budgeted position for the 2028-2029 fiscal biennium.
