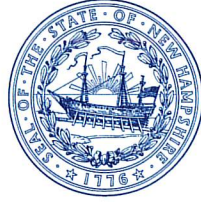

Your Excellency and Members of the Council:

REQUESTED ACTION

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to grant a salary increase to Joshua C. Harrison, as an Assistant Attorney General (Position #9U220, Appropriation #02-20-20-200510-26130000-013-500132), in the amount of \$3,000, from a salary level of \$97,200 to a salary level of \$100,200, effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval, or September 16, 2026, whichever is later. 41% General Funds; 59% Department of Environmental Services Funds.

EXPLANATION

Mr. Harrison is a Concord resident and a member of the New Hampshire Bar. He received his Bachelor of Arts degree from Susquehanna University in 2014 and his Juris Doctor from the University of New Hampshire School of Law in 2017. While in law school, he was a legal intern at the New Hampshire Department of Justice, Civil Bureau, and a legal resident at the United States District Court for the District of New Hampshire. Mr. Harrison joined the Department of Justice in October 2017 as an Attorney in the Environmental Protection Bureau. He was appointed an Assistant Attorney General in October 2018. In recognition of his performance with this Department, I have designated him as a Senior Assistant Attorney General. His salary will increase by \$3,000 from \$97,200 to \$100,200. He will continue his current assignment.

RSA 21-M:3 and RSA 94:1-a(I)(c)(3) provides that designation of positions, salary levels, and salary increases for attorneys at the Department of Justice shall be determined by the Attorney General, subject to approval of the Governor and Council, within appropriations made to the Department of Justice.
